Dear Parent / Guardian

The time has come to pay the annual subscription to the Boys' Brigade. Insurance and our Battalion and National Capitation fees take up the greater proportion of our subscriptions. It cost £7000 to run our company of 90 boys last year and the subscriptions fell short of this figure by a considerable amount. However despite this significant shortfall because of the current economic climate we have decided to keep subscription levels for 2010/11 the same, this means we anticipate a shortfall of £2000. To help compensate for this we will be holding a bag pack fund raising event which we expect all our boys to take part in.

Our subscriptions cover 39 weeks of BB activities Subscription rates for the 2010/11 are:

Anchor Boys - £45

Junior Section - £50

Company Section - £55

Please note that if the subscription is not paid by the 24th September your son will not be insured and therefore not be able to take part in any BB activities. If you have any difficulty regarding the payment of your son's subscription please contact his section leader or me in complete confidence before the above date.

Please complete the slip at the bottom of this letter and enclose it, together with your payment, either, in a sealed envelope and hand it to the leader in charge of your son's section, or alternatively during the summer break you can post it direct to our treasurer, Robert Gibb, 11 Rocket Close, Watnall. Cheques should be made out to **32nd Nottingham Company BB**

The attached consent form must be returned by 4th September.

May I remind you that the Boys' Brigade is a Christian organisation and that your son should attend Sunday School or Church worship regularly. Membership of the Boys' Brigade is an all-round commitment and not just attendance at the activities that your son particularly enjoys. I would remind you that the evening worship at 6.30 pm on the 2nd Sunday of each month at Nuthall Methodist Church is a Youth Service and ideal for young people.
